Council Member Schack, made a motion, seconded by Council Member Wilson, to direct City attorneys to reply to the letter received.

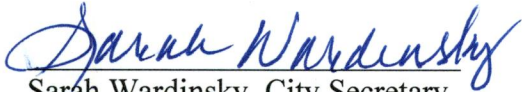
Martha Hobluetzel, Avenue A, made a citizen comment.
