1. Call Meeting to Order

- A. Director of Library Services, Belinda Casanova, reported that everything was getting back to normal at the library after the Christmas season. All programs are in full swing. The After School Program is on Tuesdays (3:45 till 5:00 PM), Game Day is on Wednesdays (4:00 till 5:30), the Under Five Program is on Fridays (9:30-10:30), Free Crochet for Beginners resumed on Mondays, January 12, (4:30-5:30), Tutoring for Children in English, reading or math on Mondays (4:00-6:00) or on Saturdays (9:00-11:00), Mr.

Kippy comes on Thursdays (3:30-4:30) and on Fridays (8:30-9:30), and One Page at a Time Program is on the third Tuesday of the month (1:30) at 612 Sand Piper, Ingleside on the Bay. There will also be a new GED class sponsored by the San Patricio County Adult Literacy Council to be held from (6:00-8:00 PM) on Wednesday and Thursdays.

- B. Ms. Casanova passed around a brochure from the Texas State Library Archives Commission. Since the United States is celebrating it's 250th anniversary, Texans want to look back over their long and storied past to remember key moments in the Lone Star State and how those moments contributed to the unfolding American story. The Commission sent the library large pictures of historical documents which Ms. Cassanova will display in the library for the public to see.
