OPENING AGENDA

1. Call Meeting to Order

The regular meeting of the Ingleside Library Board was called to order by President Agatha Snyder at 6:15 pm on March 18, 2026, at City Hall, 2671 San Angelo Ave., Ingleside TX with live video streaming.

2. Roll Call

Those in attendance were Agatha Snyder, Lana Young, Nancy White and Lou Rokohl and Belinda Casanova. Those absent were Judy Latren, Brenda Richardson and Tori Buescher. A quorum was declared.

3. Pledge of Allegiance

Those in attendance said the Pledge of Alliance.

4. Citizen Comments and Reports

There were no citizen comments for this meeting.

5. President Snyder asked if there were any questions about the previous month's minutes, after no questions, Lana Young moved they be approved as read. Nancy White seconded. Motion carried

6. Librarian's Report

- A. Director of Library Services, Belinda Casanova, reported that the Super Smashers Bros. Tournament will be held at the Ingleside Public Library meeting room. Placement matches will be on April 11, from 11:00 am to 1:00pm. Finals matches will be held on April 21 from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM. Ages 13 and up may sign up at the library.
- B. The San Patricio County Adult Literacy, Inc will hold a Scrabble Tournament for Literacy on Thursday, April 23, 2026. It will be at the Portland Community Center, 2000 Billy G. Webb Dr., Portland,

Texas 78374. It will be a meet, eat and greet with a silent auction, food, desserts, alcohol and scrabble games. The time is 5:30 to 9:30. This tournament is in support of the Adult Literacy in San Patricio County. Ms. Cassanova is gathering items for the silent auction. She said they are also selling tables and asked the City Manager and the Women's club to sponsor a table. This allows the library to buy the materials needed for our Adult Literacy Program such as a license, software and a tutor for the students. Last year \$5000 was raised.

- C. Ms. Cassanova also reported that National Library Week will be April 19-25. The theme this year is "Find Your Joy". She asked if the Woman's Club would provide the cake and help serve.
- D. Ms. Cassanova said she was working on the Texas Public Library Annual Accreditation report. The library must meet certain standards to remain accredited. This enables us to participate in the following programs: Statewide Interlibrary Loan, Technology Support, Grants and Funding, Texshare Card, and Texshare Databases. There are also other special programs that are offered. More info may be found on the TSLAC website.

7. Closing Agenda

The Board discussed the storage building with the City Manager. He said a feasibility study would have to be done. The Board said the building would have to be near the library for convenience. The consultants do not know when the library will be expanded. The librarian said she really needs something now. A storage building was mentioned. Agatha Snyder said she would report that to the Woman's Club.
