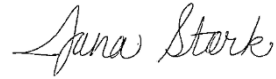

Opening Agenda

1. Call Meeting to Order

The regular meeting of the Ingleside Library Board was officially called to order at 6:01 PM on April 22, 2026. The meeting took place at City Hall, located at 2671 San Angelo Ave., Ingleside, Texas, and was accessible via live video streaming.

2. Roll Call

The following members were present at the meeting: Lana Young, Nancy White, Lou Rokohl, Brenda Richardson, Judy Latren, Tori Buescher and Belinda Casanova. Agatha Snyder was absent. A quorum was declared.

3 . Pledge of Allegiance

All attendees participated in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

4 Citizen Comments and Reports

There were no citizen comments for this meeting.

Regular Agenda

5 The city secretary inquired if there were any questions regarding the minutes from the previous month. As there were no questions, Nancy White moved to approve the minutes as read. Judy Latren seconded the motion. Motion carried.

6 Librarian's Report

1. Director of Library Services, Belinda Casanova, announced that the Summer Reading Program will begin on June 2 and will last for six weeks. They will meet twice a week. The children will be divided into different groups. Pre-K-2nd grade will be on Tuesdays from 10-11 am. Third grade-sixth grade will be on Wednesdays from 10-11 am. Mr. Kippy will be involved on Thursdays from 3:30-4:30 pm and Fridays from 8:30-9:30 am. Ms. Casanova said that flyers were passed out at the schools. Registrations begin on May 1, 2026 online or in the library.
2. The San Patricio County Adult Literacy, Inc. will be hosting a Scrabble Tournament for Literacy on Thursday, April 23, 2026, at the Portland Community Center, 2000 Billy G. Webb Dr., Portland, Texas 78374. The event will feature a meet, eat, and greet with a silent auction, food, desserts, alcohol, and Scrabble games. The tournament will run from 5:30 PM to 9:30 PM and supports adult literacy in San Patricio County. Ms. Casanova has been collecting items for the silent auction and noted one table was still available for sponsorship. She thanked the Women's Club for sponsoring a table and also contributing an item for the silent auction. The auction helps the library purchase materials needed for the Adult Literacy Program, including licenses, software, and tutoring for students. She said that the silent auction will take place from 5:30-9:30.
3. Ms. Casanova stated she finished preparing the Texas Public Library Annual Accreditation report and will need signatures from Library Board Chair.

Closing Agenda

The Board discussed the need for a storage building for the library, but the Woman's Club could not help until the city can provide more information. The Board discussed that because some of the meetings are so short that we might be able to meet every other month from September to May unless the librarian needed to have a meeting. Lou made the motion that we meet every other month from May to September unless the librarian needed to call a meeting. Tori Buescher seconded. The motion passed unanimously. The City Secretary told us that we would have to change the ordinance to do this

and take it before the City Council. We decided to discuss this again at the May meeting.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 6:12 PM.
