OPENING AGENDA

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

The Special Council Meeting of the City of Ingleside was called to order by Mayor Adame at 7:00 p.m. on May 20, 2024, at City Hall 2671 San Angelo Ave., Ingleside, TX and live video streaming.

2. ROLL CALL.

With Council Members present a quorum was established.

Council Members Present: Steve Diehl, Stewart Wilson, David Pruitt, John Salinas, Mayor Pro-Tem Tracy Long, and Mayor Adame

Council Members Absent: Julio Salinas

3. INVOCATION.

Council Member Pruitt led the invocation.

4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Mayor Adame led the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. flag.

5. CITIZEN COMMENTS AND REPORTS.

No citizen comments and reports received.

REGULAR AGENDA

6. DELIBERATE AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A WINDSTORM POLICY AGREEMENT TO BE EFFECTIVE MAY 26, 2024 AND ENDING MAY 25, 2025.

City Manager Lewis addressed the Council about the windstorm renewal policy and indicated there would be a \$36,000 savings from last year with the same carriers.

Belinda Wallace with Victor was available via Zoom and answered Council questions.

City Council expressed a concern to authorize Ms. Wallace to look into a possible six month extension option to push the renewal date out from hurricane season.

Motion: Mayor Adame made a motion to authorize the City Manager to enter into a windstorm policy agreement to be effective May 26, 2024 and ending May 25, 2025. Council Member John Salinas seconded the motion. Motion carried with all present voting in favor.

7. DELIBERATE AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO AMEND THE SPECIAL PARKS PERMIT FOR "SMOKIN' TIRES & LIGHTIN' FIRES BARBECUE COOK-OFF" ON MAY 31ST AND JUNE 1ST, 2024.

Discussion was held among the Council, City Manager and Barbara Gregg regarding the Relaxation of Noise Ordinance Standards and complaints with past events.

Motion: Council Member Diehl made a motion to approve the amendment to include the Sale and/or Consumption of Intoxicating Beverages for the Special Parks Permit for "Smokin' Tires & Lightin' Fires Barbecue Cook-Off" on May 31st and June 1st, 2024.

Council Member Wilson seconded the motion. Motion carried with all present voting in favor.

Council Member Diehl requested for an update on the City recruitment process.

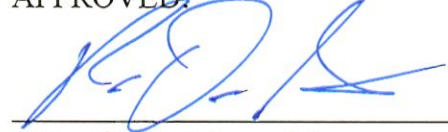
Council Member Diehl requested for Staff to look into 18 wheelers parking in the turning lane in front of Whataburger during the lunch hour.

9. ADJOURN.

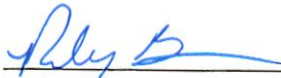
Mayor Adame adjourned the special meeting of the City of Ingleside at 7:29 p.m
