1. Call Meeting to Order.

The Special City Council Meeting of the City of Ingleside was called to order by Mayor Adame at 6:30 p.m. on September 30, 2024, at City Hall 2671 San Angelo Ave., Ingleside, TX and live video streaming.

Martha Habluetzel, 3508 Ave A, addressed the Council about the Garden Club's Plant and Miscellaneous sale, hiring and firing of employees, justification of decisions, and what does it cost the tax payers.

Courtney Shane, 2181 Capeheart, addressed the Council about her support for the City Manager, investigations into allegations, citizens showing up to meetings now, and social media posts by former employees.

Chuck Sullivan, 2627 Hwy 361, addressed the Council about the City Secretary filing a police report in Rockport, trespassing on public property, and Council needing to pay attention.

Sarah Crumbley, 2480 Henrietta Place, addressed the Council about her not supporting getting rid of the City Manager, social media posts from former employees, and the opinions of those posting on social media to make the City Manager look bad.

There were no requests made by Council Members for items to consider for placement on future agendas.

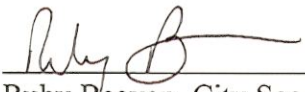
9. Adjourn.
